### **WHO IS THE CALVARY ACADEMY?**

The Calvary Academy (f/k/a Calvary Christian Academy) was founded in 1979. We are a ministry of The Calvary Church, an Apostolic Pentecostal Church.

### **WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?**

#### ***What type of school is TCA?***

We are classified as an 08 school with the state of Ohio. This means that we are non-chartered and non-tax supported. An 08 status guarantees that our promotions and graduations are recognized by the state of Ohio.

#### ***Is bus service available?***

Because we are non-chartered and non-tax supported, we do not have bus service available. Families provide transportation for their children.

#### ***Is a hot lunch provided?***

Students pack their lunches. On Friday's students have the option to purchase a pizza lunch.

#### ***How is the student exposed to Christian values?***

A weekly chapel session is conducted during which the student identifies his or her education with the ministry of Christ's kingdom. The pastor, staff members, and special guests present the Word of God. Daily devotions or Bible classes are also conducted for the various class levels.

#### ***What type of curriculum does TCA use?***

In our elementary classes, the source of most of our curriculum is ABeka. This program includes strong foundational phonics and math skills, excellent presentations in other subjects, and it is completely Bible based.

In our secondary, curriculum is primarily college preparatory. The source of our curriculum is ABeka and Bob Jones University Press. Both of these publishers provide excellent textbooks and additional materials. We also have some courses that are from other publishers.

#### ***Is there a dress code or uniform requirements?***

TCA requires that all students wear uniforms.

### **HOW DO I APPLY?**

The admissions procedure for a new student includes provision of the following:

1. A completed application form
2. Payment of the non-refundable registration fee
3. A copy of the applicant's recent report card
4. A copy of the applicant's birth certificate
5. Completed Record's Release form to obtain student records

The parent should contact the school office to schedule an interview and a time for testing if it is required. A testing fee will be incurred if the student is tested.

(per student) Phase 2 - Jan. 31, 2011 – Feb. 16, 2011 \$100  
Phase 3 - From Feb. 17, 2011 on \$125

**ENTRANCE TEST FEE \$25.00**  
(per new student) *This fee is non-refundable*

**ENROLLMENT FEE \$100.00**  
(per new student) *This fee is non-refundable*

**\*10% of the tuition and fees are applied to Activity Funds and Curriculum and is non-refundable.**

#### Payment Options :

- 1) **Eleven (11) month payment plan**— July – May. Managed by FACTS Tuition Management.
- 2) **Pre-pay discount** – 5% discount if paid in full by June 1, 2011 or 3% discount if paid in full by August 15, 2011.

**After September 1, early withdrawal fee is \$300 per child or \$500 per family.**

The complete financial policy is included in the TCA Student Handbook.

**Note: Effective with the 2011-2012 school year, the tuition discount policy has been revised. A discount is available for families who pay their balance in full prior to June 1, 2011 or August 15, 2011. Discounts are available for TCC members, families with more than one child enrolled in TCA, and scholarship recipients. Families may only take advantage of one of these discounts. To confirm your discount eligibility, please contact the school office.**

Morning care hours—7:00—8:15 a.m. – Rate: \$3 (no charge for students who arrive to school between 8:00 & 8:15 a.m.)  
After school care hours 3:15 – 5:30 p.m. – Rate: 3:15-4:00pm \$2 • 4:01-5:00pm \$2 • 5:00-5:30pm \$1  
Late charge of \$10 assessed after 5:30 p.m.
