## **STEP 3: MARCH 16<sup>TH</sup> – WE WALK!**

### **• THINGS TO KNOW –**

- 1. \$35 MINIMUM DONATION:** Students must have at least \$35 in pledges by Friday, March 16, in order to participate in the day's events.
- 2. T-SHIRTS:** all students who raise at least \$35 in pledges will receive a 2012 walk-a-thon t-shirt on the day of the walk. The t-shirt is theirs to keep.
- 3. RELEASE FORMS:** We must have a Mercy Healthplex Release form signed and turned into the school office for each student, parent or sibling who will be going to the Plex. A release form is included in each student's walk-a-thon envelope. Additional forms are available in the school office.
- 4. FRIDAY LUNCH PROVIDED:** Lunch is provided for the students AND their family members who participate on March 16. The school office needs to be informed of any family members planning to participate on Friday, March 16, so we can plan accordingly.
- 5. NO CLASSES:** There will be no classes on Friday, March 16, and students will be dismissed at 1:00 p.m. with no afternoon extended care.
- 6. FRIDAY'S DEPARTURE:** We will begin transporting students to Mercy Healthplex at 8:45 a.m. on March 16. We are using Peterman Bus Company for transportation. The students will be transported in two groups starting with the youngest to the oldest. At the healthplex they will complete a 3 mile walk around the indoor track before returning to the school for lunch. We anticipate having all students transported back to TCA by approximately 11:00 a.m.
